



DISTRICT SCHOOL WEEK FOR SCOUTING CHAMPION

Position concept:

District School Week for Scouting Champion is responsible to the District Recruiting Chair. The champion gives leadership to the development and implementation of the school week for scouting program.

Principle responsibilities:

1. Communicate with all packs in the district to secure participation in School Week for Scouting.
2. Provide to the district recruiting chair a detailed report of recruiting activities planned by each pack on a monthly basis, May-October.
3. Plan and carry out School Week for Scouting plan as developed by the council membership committee.
4. Promote, support and develop district, multi-district, or council recruiting and support events such as Webelos Woods and Tiger University.

Time requirement: Average 1-3 hours per week, but much more extensive during the primary implementation period of August-September.
