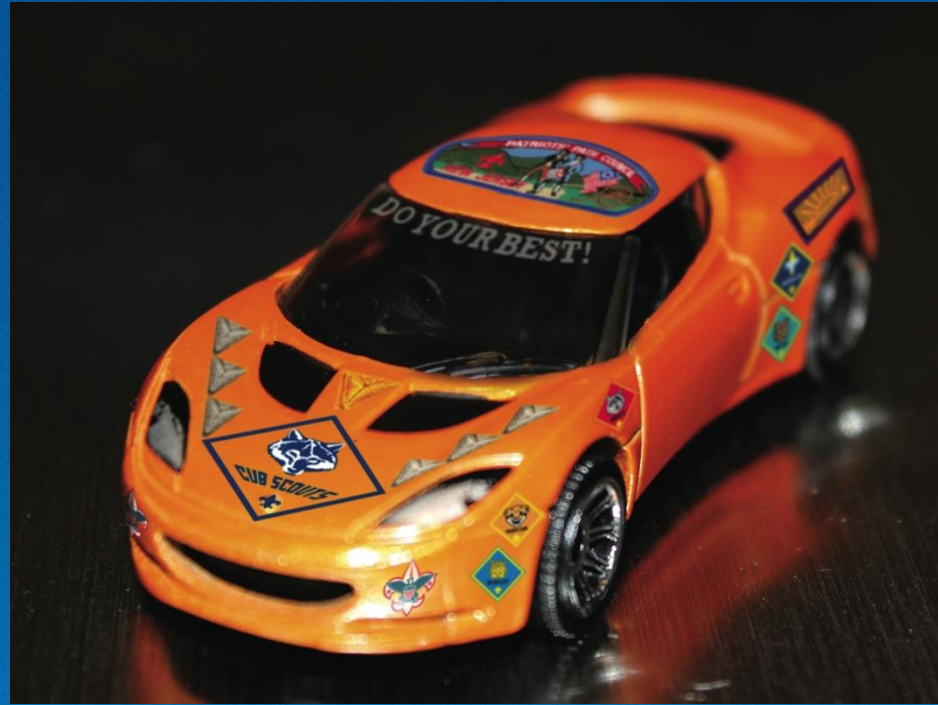

You'll need  
A steep  
Start for  
Enough speed  
to make it thru  
the loops. Sooner  
you place loop  
near the incline,  
the more speed the  
Car will have to get  
thru it. Make the loop  
no bigger than one track's  
Length. Loops are optional. Track  
can just simulate your PWD track.

**Test it. Test it. Then test it again.**

### **Support your loops.**

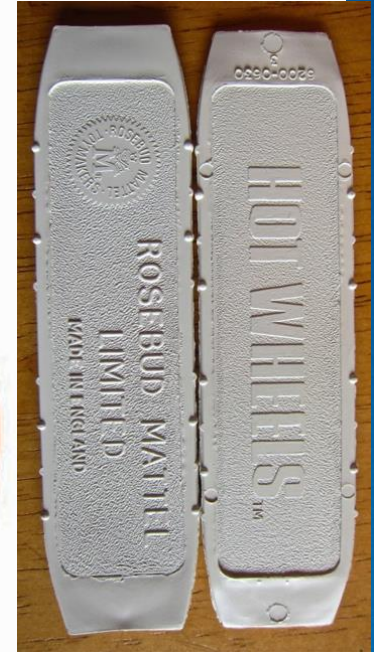
If you do not have manufacturer's loop supports, they need to be secured against wobbling when cars run thru them.

### **Tips to acquire tracks:**

- Craig's list
- eBay
  - garage sales
  - ask friends
  - check your parent's attic

### **Connectors:**

Very important and hard to come by. May need to create substitutes from a semi-flexible plastic. Needs some rigidity.

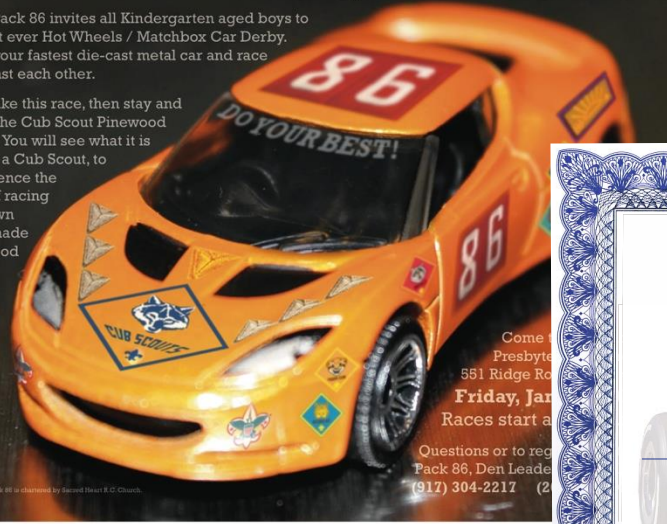

# CUB SCOUTS



## Great way to “hook” kids prior to first grade, on one of the premier activities in Cub Scouts.

Send out flyers to local school’s kindergarten classes two to three weeks prior. Have parents call you to register prior, but expect a few walk-ins too.

Plan with other den leaders in your pack for additional ideas, suggestions and supplies. Set up a 4 lane track to run their own hot-wheel cars. Run races the same night (1.5 to 2 hours prior) as your actual Pine Wood Derby so they see the real track, the cubs’ cars and the building excitement. Have a few older cubs there to help or run as you talk to parents about your program and answer their question.

Have a sign-up sheet to obtain parent’s contact information (e-mail!). Hand-out certificated to all boys (siblings can participate too) that has your contact info on it.
